Have Life Church – Virtual Bible Study: Mark 5

Mark 5 is one of the most concentrated displays of Jesus' authority in the Gospels. In one chapter, we see Him demonstrate power over demons, disease, and death. It is not just a collection of miracle stories — it is a revelation of who He is.

Quote:

Faith does not ignore reality; it invites God into it. When faith moves, heaven responds. When faith presses, power flows. When faith waits, resurrection speaks.”

Mark 5:8 (NKJV)

“For He said to him, ‘Come out of the man, you unclean spirit!’”

1. Power and Glory of God in Mark 5
2. Faith is Active Trust (Moves • Presses • Waits)
3. Authority Over Darkness (Demon-Possessed Man)
4. Healing Through Persistent Faith (Woman with the Issue of Blood)
5. Resurrection Power & Waiting Faith (Jairus' Daughter)
6. Miracles are Mission: Testimony, Restoration, and Glory to God

Dr. Sho's Big Point:

In Mark 5, we witness Jesus' complete authority—over what binds us, what drains us, and what looks dead. Faith is not passive agreement; it is active trust. It moves toward Jesus, presses through obstacles, and waits when the moment feels delayed. When faith interrupts the impossible, heaven invades earth—power is released and God gets the glory.
