

**Group #3: I Am Not Ashamed** 

### Romans 1:15-17 (NASB95) —

15 So, for my part, I am eager to preach the gospel to you also who are in Rome. 16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

Pastor's Big Point: People tend to be more verbal concerning the things we are most proud of or the things we hold most dear to our hearts. If you went to a social gathering with someone you thought you were dating exclusively, and they introduced you as 'just a friend,' you might feel some kind of way. Is it possible that Jesus is in love with you, but you're telling everyone that you're just acquaintances? Do you only call Him when you need Him, while you're still shopping around for what you want? You can't treat God like He's one of your "friends with benefits." At some point, you've got to let God know if He's in this relationship alone. You need not be ashamed of your salvation and sanctification in Christ Jesus.



### **Group #3: I Am Not Ashamed**



Shame is defined as a painful feeling of humiliation or distress caused by the consciousness of wrong-doing or foolish behavior. It is synonomous with dishonor, or a loss of respect or esteem. How might we be carrying shame about our relationship with God?
